Nominees should demonstrate their potential in philanthropy by demonstrating one or more of the following:

- Exemplary leadership in advancing philanthropy
- Engagement beyond a single community
- Creativity in a philanthropic endeavor or project
- Significant accomplishment in a short period of time

How to enter:

- 1 Complete the nomination form;
- 2 Write a letter describing the nominee's exemplary contributions as detailed above; and
- 3 Submit any supplemental materials that support your nomination.

The Philanthropy Ohio Board of Trustees (who are not eligible for nomination) will select the winner, who will receive the award during Philanthropy Forward, October 22 – 24, 2018, in Columbus.
