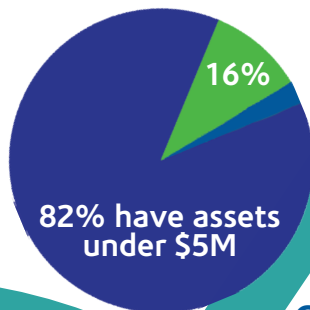
The number of Ohio foundations held steady in 2016.

Most foundations are small, with assets under \$5 million.

16% have \$5-\$50M in assets
2% have assets over \$50M



INDIVIDUAL GIVING

Ohioans gave more to charities in 2016, up 2%.



18% of individuals had income less than \$50,000 and gave \$507 million, 9% of all gifts. The average gift was \$2,428.

12% of individuals had income more than \$200,000 and gave \$2.32 billion, 42% of all gifts. The average gift was \$16,446.

FOUNDATIONS GAVE 20%

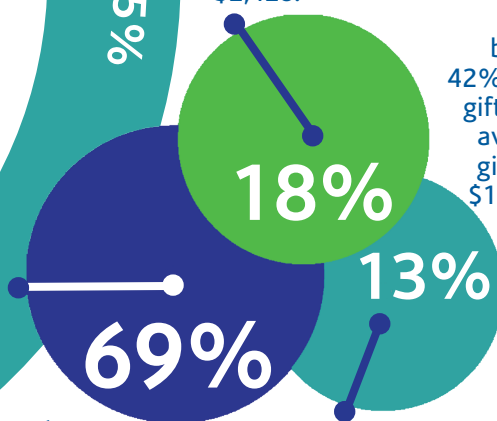
Total Ohio Giving rose modestly in 2016, up by less than 1 percent.

Individuals gave \$5.98 billion

United Ways and others gave \$394 million



69% of individuals had income between \$50,000 – \$200,000 and gave \$2.76 billion, 48% of all gifts. The average gift was \$3,510.

United Way giving was down. Of the 76 United Ways in Ohio, most are small giving less than \$1 million. Three gave more than \$10M and 15 gave between \$1M – \$10M.
