
A glance back at 2022



We Advocated

- STATE POLICY: Defeated language that would have negatively impacted donor contributions and donor intent and submitted letters to Governor DeWine and Attorney General Yost with suggested improvements to the OneOhio Recovery Foundation.
- **HEALTH & EDUCATION REFORM:** Continued to fight divisive concepts bills (HB 322 & 327); celebrated the extension of postpartum care under Medicaid; lobbied for Medicaid to cover doula services; joined the Hunger-Free Schools Ohio coalition to push for universal school meals.
- FEDERAL POLICY: Convened legislators on ACE Act, S 1981 ramifications regarding donor advised funds; advocated for a permanent Universal Charitable Deduction; lobbied for a federal government seat at the table for the nonprofit and social sector.

- Philanthropy Forward '22 took place in person for the first time in three years. In October, 296 attendees convened in Cleveland to connect with one another, build skills as leaders and strengthen this network of funder peers. 16 nonprofit leaders attended the closing lunch.
