A glance back at 2023



We Advocated

- STATE POLICY: Celebrated successful expansion of free and reduced meals for students; passage of Medicaid coverage for doula services; and expansion of OCOG in the state biennium budget. Advocated for continued phase in of the Fair School Funding Plan; access to whole-child comprehensive supports in schools; high-quality early learning; and investments to boost college affordability. Opposed Issue 1 in the Aug. 8 special election and celebrated its defeat, which sought to change Ohio's constitutional amendment process. Defeated harmful endowed funds language in the state budget (H.B.33).
- representation FEDERAL POLICY: Advocated for the Charitable Act and the newly introduced reverse scholarship legislation.
- Set a Democracy Table for funders to explore building and supporting a range of issues from civic engagement to redistricting.
